Home Health Aide

Home Health Aides in the Caring R Us Homecare and Nursing Staffing Agency Team are licensed, bonded and insured and ready to be assigned and care for you at home.

Care Management

Services in this program include setting up medical appointments, preparing weekly medication intake and prescription supply monitoring.

Sitter Services

ADULT FOSTER CARE (AFC)

Adult Foster Care (AFC), also called Adult Family Care, is a program designed to help people on MassHealth age 16 or older with disabilities who cannot live alone safely.

This program provides 24-hour family living for elderly persons and disabled adults who due to frailty, chronic illness or advanced age who prefers to live in a family setting rather than in a nursing home or other facility.

AFC adults live with trained paid caregivers who provide daily care. Caregivers may be family members(except legally responsible relatives), or non-family members.

To be eligible for Adult Family Care:

- must be 16 years of age or older
- must need daily assistance with one or more activities of daily living (ADLs)
- must be unable to live alone because of a medical, physical, cognitive or mental condition and need supervision
- must be willing to live with your caregiver
- you must be eligible for MassHealth or able to pay privately
- your caregiver cannot be your spouse or a relative legally responsible for you.
- (Note: For a minor child, the caregiver cannot be a parent)
- must be approved and have written order for AFC by a physician and the agency responsible for determining AFC eligibility.

Requirements for Caregivers:

- Must be at least 18 years of age
- Can be biologically related to the person needing care, but cannot be the legal guardian or spouse
- Must be willing to share life and home with the person needing assistance
- Must be able to accept responsibility for the person's care and supervision of all health related activities

Your caregiver will receive:

- up to \$1500 non-taxable pay per month for caregiver services (\$18,000 per year), depending on the level of care .
